Product Description: GoReact is a web-based application that assists coaches in giving real-time feedback to learner videos (such as sign-language, foreign language, performing arts, etc).

Evaluation Methods Used: Testing GoReact involved extensive use of leading assistive technology including NVDA, JAWS and VoiceOver screen readers, Dragon Professional speech recognition software, Windows High Contrast themes, screen magnifiers, as well as exclusive use of the keyboard. Native platform accessibility features were also used to assist with testing.
